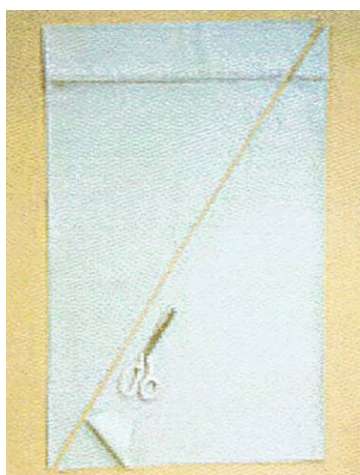


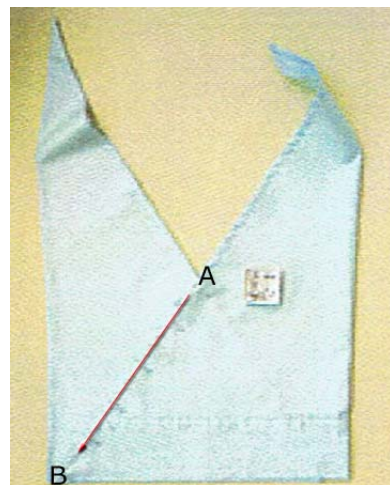
### Requirements

- 1 x pillowcase
- Matching thread

1. Trim 6mm off the closed bottom end of pillowcase i.e. the hem.
2. Cut the pillowcase in half on the diagonal (see Picture 1).
3. Turn the fabric of each of the four diagonal cut edges over by 6mm twice and pin. Using your # 10 foot, line the guard up against the edge, move your needle position to the left 2x, and sew a hem. You will be sewing along the very edge of the fabric for a perfect finish.
4. Place one pillowcase half inside the other, right sides facing out.
5. Line up at the bottom edges, pin and sew at the front where the fabrics overlap (from A to B in Picture 2)
6. Repeat on the other side of the bag.
7. Turn fabric inside out and hem the pillowcase's cut bottom edge.
8. Finish the seam with an overlocker or use a zig zag stitch.
9. Turn the pillowcase right side out and tie top ends into a knot.
